**Notes on Gift Aid
declaration**

1. One declaration is all that is needed to enable SIM to claim back the tax on all your gifts of any amount or frequency.
2. The individual signing this form must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that SIM reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).
NB: In order to claim the tax back the signature on the Banker's Order Form or cheque must be the same as the signature on the Gift Aid Declaration.
3. Please notify SIM if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
4. If, in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax equal to the tax that SIM reclaims, you can cancel your declaration by notifying SIM. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such earlier or later date you specify.
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, or have any other queries, please telephone, write or fax the Finance Department at SIM. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR65 Gift Aid.
